Dear Kensington Residents,

It has been brought to our attention that several Kensington residents have been driving through the area where the lake bank stabilization work is taking place near Wellington II and Nottingham Cove (Keswick) much faster than is safe. In addition, many folks are so interested in the equipment in that location that they are “rubber necking” and taking their eyes off the road increasing the chance of an accident occurring. We have asked the contractor to put out some additional signage in the area reducing speeds to 5 MPH to help reduce the chance that someone will be seriously hurt.

So please slow down when passing through the “roundabout” on the Southernmost section of Kensington High Street.
