Landscaping update:

The end of August, Crawford Landscape will be trimming over 1,400 palm trees along the perimeter of Kensington High Street. This also includes Canterbury Green's Buffer Zone. In July, 200 Oak trees were trimmed on Kensington High Street to 16 feet elevation. (It's a jungle out there...)

Access and Patrol update:

The speed bumps have been installed at the Eatonwood and Kensington High Intersection. Below is a picture of the bumps. As we stated in the Summer Newsletter this is a trial period. When the "Season" begins, Securitas the newly hired access and patrol company, will be assessing to see if the speed bumps are helping, and then decide whether to remove, or add more speed bumps at other busy traffic areas in Kensington.
